

BACK PANEL



- 1. USB SLOT: Insert USB Drive to listen stream music
- 2. MEMORY CARD SLOT: Insert Media card to stream music
- 3. AUX IN: Connect external media player using 3.5mm line in cable (Cable not included)
- 4. POWER LED: Turns on when unit is powered on.
- 5. MIC VOLUME: Increase/Decrease Microphone Volume
- 6. MICROPHONE JACK: (MICROPHONE NOT INCLUDED): Plug in Microphone for Karaoke
- 7. MASTER VOLUME: Increase/Decrease Volume
- 8. TUNE: Adjust sound effect
- 9. DC 5V POWER INPUT: Use included charging cable to charge unit. Adaptor not included
- 10. CHARGING INDICATOR: Red = charging, Green = fully charged
- 11. POWER ON/OFF: Turn ON/OFF unit's power supply
- 12. LIGHT ON/OFF: Turn On/Off Woofer Light while unit is powered on
- 13. LED DISPLAY: Displays status
- 14. MODE: Toggle between source BT/USB/ Memory Card /FM/Aux. Long Press to turn ON/OFF voice prompt
- 15. RECORD: Long Press to record audio on Memory Card or USB while using Microphone, press again to stop recording and listen to playback. Insert Memory Card or USB drive with enough blank space to Record.
- 16. REPEAT: Press to repeat current track, press again to repeat all tracks in the Album
- 17. PREVIOUS: Select previous track in USB/ Memory Card Modes, Select previous preset frequency in FM mode
- 18. PLAY/PAUSE: Play or Pause in BT/USB/ Memory Card Mode, Scan for available frequencies in FM Mode, Mute in Aux Mode. Long press to change voice prompt form English to Chinese OR Chinese to English
- 19. NEXT: Select next track in USB/ Memory Card Modes, Select next preset frequency in FM mode
- 20. TELESCOPIC ANTENNA: Extend Antenna for better reception of FM frequencies

REMOTE CONTROL



- 1. MUTE: Press to off audio
- 2. MODE: Toggle between source BT/USB/Memory Card/FM/Aux. Long Press to turn ON/OFF voice prompt
- 3. RECORD: Record Audio while using microphone
- 4. VOLUME UP: Increase Volume
- 5. PLAY/PAUSE: Play or Pause in BT/USB/Memory Card Mode, Scan for available frequencies in FM Mode. Long press to change voice prompt form English to Chinese OR Chinese to English
- 6. PREVIOUS: Select previous track in USB/Memory Card Modes, Select previous preset frequency in FM mode
- VOLUME DOWN: Reduce Volume
- 8. REPEAT: Press to repeat current track or press again to play all tracks in album
- 9. RECORD PLAY: Play recording
- NEXT: Select next track in USB/Memory Card Modes,
 Select next preset frequency in FM mode
- 11. EQ: Select Present Sound effects
- 12. NUMBER KEY 0-9: Press track number to play the track in USB/Memory Card mode

POWER SUPPLY

- Connect the supplied USB cable unito to a 5V USB outlet to charge the unit.
- 2. Switch the Power button to turn On and Off the unit.

PAIRING A BLUETOOTH® DEVICE

- Press the "MODE" button to select Bluetooth® Mode. The screen will display the word "Blue".
- 2. From your Bluetooth® enabled device, search for "SOUND PRO NDS-1213" and select it to pair.
- 3. Press the Play/Pause button to Pause or resume playback.
- 4. Tracks can be changed from your connected Bluetooth® enabled device.
- 5. Only one device can be connected through Bluetooth® at a time.

AUX IN

- 1. Press the "MODE" button to select the AUX function.
- 2. Press the Play/Pause button to Mute the sound on the unit.
- 3. Plug in an external device to the AUX jack to listen to audio through the speaker. (AUX cable not included)

PLAYBACK ON USB/MEMORY CARD

- Insert a USB flash drive and/or Memory card in the slots provided. Please make sure you use the correct file format in your media devices - MP3 FILES ONLY.
- 2. Press the MODE button to select the USB input. Press the MODE button to switch between USB and Memory Card inputs. Playback will automatically start. Please ensure that the speaker is fully charged & that your files are are in MP3 format.
- 3. Screen will display U/TF and Track played time.
- 4. Press the Previous or Next button to skip to the previous or next tracks.
- 5. Pres the Play/Pause button to to Pause or resume playback.
- 6. Press the "Repeat" button to repeat current track, repeat all tracks.

USING A MICROPHONE

1. Plug in a Microphone into the Microphone jack to sing along on any input.

FM RADIO

- 1. Press the "MODE" button to select FM Radio.
- 2. Long press the Play/Pause button to auto scan all available radio frequencies. It will search and automatically store all available.
- 3. Press Next or Previous to select desired stored stations.
- 4. The LED Display will show the selected station.
