- 5 Do not use the product in a hazardous location.

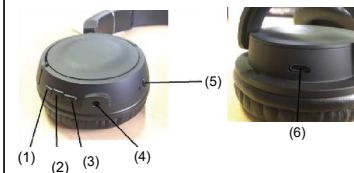

#### 4.How To Use

##### 4.1.General Functions

Desired Result	Required Action
Turn on & Enter the pairing mode	Hold the Power Button to turn on. LED light will begin flashing blue.
Pairing	Use a Bluetooth® enabled mobile phone or other Bluetooth® enabled device to perform necessary pairing actions.
Turn off	Hold the Power Button.
Charging	Plug the Micro USB plug into the micro USB charging port.
Answering a Call	Press Play/Pause to answer calls. Press Play/Pause to end calls. Hold Play/Pause for 2 seconds to refuse calls.
Play / Pause Music	Press the Play/Pause button in standby to play music. Press again to pause.
Vol-/ Previous Track	Hold the - button to decrease the volume. Press to go to the previous track.
Vol+/ Next Track	Hold the + button to increase the volume. Press to skip to the next track.

#### 4.2.Pairing to a mobile phone

To use your Bluetooth® headphones, you must first pair your headphones with a phone. Once your Bluetooth® headphones are paired to mobile phone, they will remain paired and automatically recognize each other whenever they are within range.

##### Pairing to a Bluetooth® Enabled Mobile Phone

- Turn on your phone and ensure the Bluetooth function is activated.
- Hold the Power Button till the headphones turn on and the LED indicator light begins flashing blue.
- Search the Bluetooth® devices on your phone by following the phone's instructions. Refer to your phone's user manual for more information.
- After a few seconds the phone will list the "NAXA NE-975" as a discovered device. Select it. Follow your phone's instructions to establish a pairing. Enter "0000" if a password prompt appears.
- Upon successful connection, the LED indicator light will remain blue and the headphones will beep once.

#### 4.3.Charging your headphones

Use the Micro USB cable provided with these earphones. Connect the Micro USB plug to the Micro USB charging port on the right earcuff of the headphones. Connect the USB plug to a USB port on a computer or wall adapter to begin charging.

**\* Before initial use, fully charge the headphones.**  
**\*\* The LED indicator light will be red while the headphones are charging. The light will turn blue when ready for use.**



##### Warning:

- You must select a qualified charger from a regular manufacturer.
- You must charge the Bluetooth headphones if it has been not used for more than 12 months.

#### 6.Notes

1. These headphones also allow you to listen to music from external devices via the 3.5mm auxiliary port. Plug one end of the included Aux cable into the auxiliary port and the other end in the aux-out port of external media device you wish to play audio from.  
 \* The headphones do not need to be on when in Aux mode.
2. Never use these headphones near water or in damp environments.
3. Always make sure your hands are dry when handling these headphones.
4. These headphones are intended for personal use only. Commercial use voids the warranty and the supplier cannot be held responsible for injury or damage.
5. Keep these headphones out of the reach of children.
