

Whenever convenient, use the power supply if you want to conserve battery life. Make sure you remove the plug from the set and wall outlet before inserting

Batteries (not included)

Power Supply

Open the battery compartment and insert eight batteries, type R-14, UM-2 or C-cells, (preferably Alkaline) with the correct polarity as indicated by the "+" and "-" symbols inside the compartment.

Batteries contain chemical substances, so they should be disposed of properly.

Incorrect use of batteries can cause electrolyte leakage and will corrode the compartment or cause

- the batteries to burst. Therefore: Do not mix battery types: e.g. alkaline with carbon zinc. Only use batteries of the same type for the
- When inserting new batteries, do not try to mix old batteries with the new ones.
- . Remove the batteries if the set is not to be used

Using AC Power

- Check if the power voltage, as shown on the type plate located on the bottom of the set, corresponds to your local AC power supply. If it does not, consult your dealer or service center.
- Connect the power cord to the AC MAINS inlet and the wall outlet. The power supply is now connected and ready for use.
- 3 To switch off completely, unplug the power cord from the wall outlet.
- Unplug the power cord from the wall outlet to protect your set during heavy thunderstorms.

BASIC FUNCTIONS

Switching power on/off: Save energy

Whether you are using mains or battery supply, to avoid unnecessary energy consumption always adjust

General operation

too strong (very close to a transmitter).
For AM the set is provided with a built-in antenna so the telescopic antenna is not needed. Direct the antenna by turning the whole set.

CD PLAYER

CD Player Playing a CD

This CD-player can play Audio Discs, CD-R and CD-Rewritables. Do not try to play CD-ROM, CDi, VCD, DVD or computer CD.

- Adjust the source selector to CD.

 Display: shows Briefly.
 To open the CD door, lift the CD door at the edge marked OPEN/CLOSE.
- 3 Insert a CD, CD-R or CD-RW with the printed side Facing up and press the CD door gently close.
- 4 Press > on the set to start playback.

- 6 To stop CD playback, press STOP =

Note: CD play will also stop when:

- you open the CD compartment;
 you select RADIO sound source;
- the CD has reached to the end.

Finding a passage within a track

- 1 Press and hold down He or HH
- The CD is played at high speed and low volume. 2 When you recognize the passage you want release
- Normal playback resumes

Programming track numbers

You may store up to 20 tracks in the desired nce. If you like, store any track more than once. 1 In the STOP mode, press +- or >- for your desired

Reviewing your set program

 In the STOP mode, press PROG MODE.
 The display shows your stored track numbers in sequence.

Erasing a program

- You can erase the contents of the memory by: - opening the CD door; - selecting RADIO source;
- pressing # (twice during playback or in the stop

Press stop button to enter into stop mode, prees Random button once then press play/pause button to carry out random play, "RANDOM" will appear in display. All tracks on the disc will be played in random order, then will stop. During random playing. To cancel random play, press stop button twice
