TV Bracket assemble

Fix the TV on the wall

To mount your TV to a wall, you will need a wall mount kit. You can find a variety of mounts at your local electronics retailer. Make sure that your kit is specified to support the VESA mount pattern and weight of the unit. Refer to the Specifications section of this manual before purchasing your wall mount kit.

Naxa Electronics recommends that wall mounting be performed by a qualified professional installer. Naxa is not liable for any accidents or damage to property or TV due to incorrect installation.

- 1. Carefully place the TV face down on a cushioned surface and then follow the instructions below.
- 2. Use a screwdriver to remove the screws that fix the stand to the bottom of the TV (refer to photos 1 and 2). Carefully remove the screws and stand.
- 3. Measure the distance between the mounting holes on the TV. Use a piece of stiff paper to create a template to drill matching holes in the wall.
- 4. Drill the holes in the wall. Make sure to use screws that are appropriate for your installation and that can support the weight of the TV.
- 5. Follow the instructions provided by the mounting bracket manufacturer to complete the mounting process.

- 1. The bracket fixed on the wall is optional part.
- 2.when you assemble the TV, there should be no other articles on the around and front and please keep the distance from other articles.
- 3. Use a qualified professional installer to avoid danger from improper installation.

【Hotel Mode】

Set hotel mode On or Off. Note: The following settings work only when Hotel Mode is set to be On.

[Picture Mode]

Adjust picture mode to change picture appearance. Press ◀/ ▶ button to select(Standard / Dynamic / Soft / User).

【Default Volume】

Set the default volume for every time you open the TV, the default volume is 20.

【Max Volume】

Set the max volume that you can adjust.

[Boot Source]

Set the default input source when turning on your TV.

[Boot Channel]

Set boot channel On or Off. Note:Channel Select is available when Boot Channel is set to be On.

[Channel Select]

Set boot default on what channels. After channel searching, channels in the list can be selected.

[Hotel Lock]

To lock the Tuner/Key Pad/Menu Lock that you want. Channel searching is invalid when Tuner Lock is set to be On



[Power Save]

Set a timer for the TV to turn off automatically. Available Timer:60Min,120Min,180Min,240Min,Off

[TV to USB]

Backup data to USB.

USB to TV Restore data from USB.

[Reset Hotel Setting]

Recall the default settings of Hotel menu.

Channel Menu

PC Menu
