# **DISC HANDLING AND MAINTENANCE**

# Handling precautions

- Hold the disc by the edges so the surface will not be soiled with fingerprints. Fingerprints, dirt and scratches can cause skipping and distortion.
- Do not write on the label side with a ball-point pen or other writing utensils.

# **DEFINITION OF TERMS**

#### DVD

This refers to a high-density optical disc on which high-quality pictures and sound have been obtained by means of digital signals. Incorporation a new video compression technology (MPEG II) and high-density recording tech-nology, DVD enables aesthetically pleasing full-motion video to be recorded over long periods of time (for instance, a whole movie can be recorded). DVD has a structure consisting of two 0.6 mm thin discs which are adhered to each other. Since the thinner the disc, the higher the density at which the information can be recorded, a DVD disc has a greater capacity than a single 1.2 mm thick disc. Since the two thin discs are adhered to each other, there is the potential to achieve double-sided play sometime in the future for even longer duration play.

#### Video CD

This contains recordings of pictures and sound whose quality is on a par with that of video tape. This player also supports Video CDs with playback control (version 2.0).

#### Mp3

These contain recordings of music which are compressed, allowing a significantly larger amount of music to be stored on a CD.

#### Angle

Recorded onto some DVD discs are scenes which have been simultaneously shot from a number of different angles (the same scene is shot from the front, from the left side, from the right side, etc.). With such discs, the ANGLE button can be used to view the scene from different angles.

#### Subtitles

This is the appearance of the dialogue at the bottom of the screen which are prerecorded on some DVD discs.

#### Title number

These numbers are recorded on DVD discs. When a disc contains two or more movies, these movies are numbered as title 1, title 2, etc.

#### Chapter number

These numbers are recorded on DVD discs. A title is sub-divided into many sections, each of which is numbered, and specific parts of video presentations can be searched quickly using these numbers.

#### Time number

This indicates the play time which has elapsed from the start of a disc or a title. It can be used to find a specific scene quickly. (It may not work with some discs.)


# Playback control (PBC)

This is recorded on a Video CD (version 2.0). The scenes or information to be viewed (or listened to) can be selected interactively with the TV monitor by looking at the menu shown on the TV monitor.

#### Track number

These numbers are assigned to the tracks which are re-corded on Video CDs and CDs. They enable specific tracks to be located quickly.

#### **6 SYSTEM SETUP**



#### **6.1 FACTORY RESET**

- -It is used to reset to factory settings.
- -Press up/down button to select this item, then press right button to enter.

#### **6.2 TIME SETUP**

#### 6.2.1 Clock

- -The Clock displays the current time from programs.(this option is not user adjustable) 6.2.2 Time Zone
- -To set the time zone: Eastern, Samoa, Hawaii, Alaska, Pacific, Mountain, Central, Atlantic and Newfoundland.

#### 6.2.3 Daylight Saving

- -it is used to set daylight saving time.
- -Press up/down button to select it, then press left/right to set it ON/OFF.

#### 6.3 OSD LANGUAGE

- -Press up/down button to select this item, then press left/right button to change the OSD language.
- -Option: English or other languages. It depends on the software.

#### **6.4 AUDIO LANGUAGE**

- -It is used to set the audio language.
- -Press up/down button to select it, then press left/right button to select the language as desired.

#### **6.5 RF OUTPUT**

- -It is used to set the radio fregency output mode.
- -Press up/down button to select it.then press left/right button to change it.
- -Option: CH3, CH4 and Loop Though

#### 6.6 SCREEN

- -It is used to select screen display mode.
- -Press up/down button to select this item, and press left/right button to change the mode.
- -Option:4:3/16:9

#### 6.7 FOR MAT

- -It is used to select the format mode.
- -Option:Normal

- Do not use record cleaning sprays, benzine, thinner, static electricity prevention liquids.
- Be careful not to drop or bend the disc.
- Do not install more than 1 disc on the disc compartment.
- Do not try to close the disc cover when the disc is not installed properly.
- Be sure to store the disc in its exclusive case when not in use.

#### If the surface is soiled

Wipe gently with a soft, damp (water only) cloth.

When wiping discs, always move the cloth from the centre hole toward the outside, which will not cause distortion. (If you wipe the discs using a circular motion, circular scratches are likely to occur, which will cause distortion.)

# If the disc is brought from a cold to a warm environment moisture may form on the disc

Wipe this moisture off with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth before using the disc.

#### Improper disc storage


You can damage discs if you store them in the following places:

- Areas exposed to direct sunlight
- Humid or dusty areas
- Areas directly exposed to a heat outlet or heating appliance

#### Maintenance

- Be sure to press POWER to set the player to the standby mode and disconnect the AC adaptor before maintaining the player.
- Wipe the player with a dry, soft cloth.
- If the surfaces are extremely dirty, wipe clean with a cloth which has been dipped in a weak soap-and-water solution and wrung out thoroughly, and then wipe again with a dry cloth.
- Never use alcohol, benzine, thinner, cleaning fluid or other chemicals. And do not use compressed air to remove dust

#### 5.PROGRAM CONTROL SETUP

Input Password
— — — — Please enter the password by 0-9

-Press up or down button to select this item, and press right button to enter INPUT PASSWORD page, Input 0000(In this unit, the original password is 0000) to enter PROGRAM CONTROL page as above. These setting allow certain people to view certain channels, which may be especially useful to forbid children from viewing some unbefitting channels.

#### **5.1 V-CHIP SETTING**

- -Press right button to enter this sub-menu.
- 5.1.1 Movie ratings
- -Press right button enter MOVIE RATINGS sub-menu.
- -Press up/down button to select item as desired and press OK button to set it.
- -Option: G,PG,PG-13,R,NC-17,X and Y.
- 5.1.2 USATV Content ratings
- -Press right button enter this sub-menu.
- -Press up/down button to select item as desired and press OK button to set it.

Enter new password in the NEW PASSWORD row, after that the system will require you to confirm the new password. Then enter the new password again in the CONFIRM PASSWORD row. If success, massage "Change Password Success!" will appear in the screen.

**NOTE:** The original password is 0000, you can change it, but you should write it down and keep it safe. If you forget the password, please contact with the supplier.

OFF: If SKIP OFF, all the channel numbers (the channels are stored in the unit) can be accessed using CH- or CH+ button.







# **CONTROL REFERENCE GUIDE**

#### Main unit



- 1 External Antenna Jack- When the signal is too weak, connect a external antenna to this jack for a better reception.
- 2 TFT Display Window- Displays all information about DVD/TV work scene.
- 3 Built-in Speaker.
- **4 SWITCH button-** Press this button to switch the unit between TV and DVD mode.
- **5 PLAY/PAU SE button** Press this button to start or pause playing a disc.
- 6 UP/CH+ button- Press this button to up, and in DVD mode, if you keep pressing it for more than 2 seconds, the player will skip to the previous chapter or title(for DVD)or track (for CD). In TV mode, press this button to play the next channel.
- 7 DOWN/CH- button- Press this button to down, and in DVD mode, if you keep pressing it for more than 2 seconds, the player will skip to the next chapter or title(DVD) or track (for CD).In TV mode, press this button to play the previous channel.
- 8 MENU/OK button- Press this button to confirm an operation. In DVD mode, press it for a long time to return to the root menu(for DVD) or to turn on/off the PBC (for VCD). In TV mode, press it for a long time to enter TV settings menu page.
- **9 LEFT/FR button-** Press LEFT button to left, and if you keep pressing it for more than 2 seconds, the player will play the disc backward at speed:x2,x4,x8,x16,x32.
- 10 RIGHT/FF button- Press RIGHT button to right, and if you keep pressing it for more than 2 seconds, the player will play the disc forward at speed:x2,x4,x8,x16,x32.







#### Rechargeable Battery Use

The player built-in a chargeable Lithium battery.

#### 1.Charge the battery

- -Connect the adaptor to the DC 12V IN jack, then set the unit in POWER ON mode (THE PLAYING MODE) for fully charge.
- -Set in POWER ON mode and press the STANDBY button (THE STANDBY MODE) or set in POWER OFF mode for fully charge.

And the indicator is red during charging; it gets green when charging is completed.

#### 2. Time to recharge the battery

Charge the built-in battery pack 8 hours before using the player for the first time. Recharge and playback time depends on battery pack capacity and the temperature condition. Generally speaking. The battery needs to be charged about 4 hours.

#### 3. Using and Maintaining Rechargeable Battery

- -. The normal working condition temperature is: 0 ~45;
- -. Always unplug AC/DC power supply for the unit whenever not playing.

NOTE: A new battery pack which has not been used or one which has not been used for more than a month, may appear to not recharged enough, this is due to the characteristic of this battery and is not a malfunction. In this case, recharge it two or three times before the first use, and it needs more than 8 hours to recharge battery.

Noises may be generated during recharging. In this case, use a more distant power socket. Do not recharge or discharge battery near a heating element such as a heater or direct sunlight.





#### Service life of battery


- The battery normally last for about one year although this depends on how often the remote control is used.
- If the remote control fails to work even when it is operated near the player, replace the battery.
- Use one type CR2025 battery.

#### Note:

- Do not use rechargeable (Ni-Cd) battery.
- Do not attempt to recharge, short-circuit, disassemble, heat or throw the batteries into the fire.
- Do not drop, step on or otherwise impact the remote control. This may damage the parts or lead to malfunction.
- If the remote control is not going to be used for a long time, remove the battery.

# Remote control operation

- 1. Remove the protective plastic tab before operating the remote control.
- 2. Keep the remote control from no more than 6m from the DVD player and within about 60° of the front of the player (Fig 2).
- NOTE: The operating distance may vary according to the brightness of the room.
- Do not point bright lights at remote control sensor.
- Do not place objects between the remote control and the remote control sensor.
- Do not use this remote control while simultaneously operating the remote control of any other equipment.

- Press FF or FRbutton to enlarge or shrink picture to 50%, 75%, 100%, 125%, 150% and 200%.





If the picture is enlarged, you may press the navigation buttons to pan across other portions of the picture.
