- Before performing work, spread cushioning over the base are to lay the LED TV on, in order to prevent it from being damaged.



### **WALL MOUNTING**

Your LED TV is able to accommodate wall mounting with the use of a wall mount bracket (not supplied with LED TV, please contact your local hardware store) and the mounting holes on the back of the unit. We recommend removing the TV stand prior to wall mounting the TV. Please see previous page for instructions on removing the stand.




### Wall-Mounting Instruction:

- 1. The wall-mounting bracket is suited for 23 to 49-inch flat TVs with a wall-mounting hole distance of 100 or 200mm. (The wall-mounting hole on the back panel should be smooth.)
- 2. Punch three holes into the wall, according to the wall-mounting bracket (3).
- 3. Insert the nylon anchors (2) into the corresponding holes in the wall.
- 4. Fix the wall-mounting bracket (3) with self-tapping screws (4) into the nylon anchors (2) on the wall.
- 5. Screw the wall-mounting screws (5) into the upper two screw holes on the back panel.
- 6. Lift the TV and hang it on the wall, recommended to do so with the aid of another individual.


### **OVERVIEW OF BACK PANEL**

You can connect the TV with video devices, such as DVD/VCD players, VCRs, and video cameras to enjoy more media in high-quality resolution.



### **OVERVIEW OF BUTTONS**


The buttons on the lower-left panel control your TVs basic features, including the onscreen menu. To use the more advanced features, you must use the remote control.



- 1. U Turn the TV on/off.
- 2. ▶II Press to start or pause playback.
- 3. ▲ Eject DVD/CD. Press to directly enter the channel search mode.
- 4. **VOL-**5. **VOL+**/-: Adjust Volume
- 6. **CH-**7. **CH+**CH+/-: Select Channel
- 8. **MENU** Enter or exit the menu screen (USE CH+/- button to select an item, VOL+/-button to adjust an item).
- 9. Input Input selected.

### **OVERVIEW OF REMOTE CONTROL**

- 1. POWER: Turn the TV on and off.
- 2. **INPUT:** This button is used to switch between different sources. Select an input and press ENTER to confirm.
- 3. **Digital Buttons (0-9):** Directly select channel with digial buttons.
- 4. RECALL: Switch to the previous program.
- 5. **YouTube:** If network connects, press this key to view YouTube directly.
- 6. -: Press this button to enter a program number with different digits.
- 7. **CC/SUBTITLE:** In DTV source, this button is used for subtitle language. In USB source, this button is used to change subtitles.
- 8. **HOME:** Press to go to the App home page.
- 9. **NETFLIX**: If network connects, press this key to view NETFLIX directly.
- 10. **MENU:** Display the main menu or exit the current menu.
- 11. **Q. MENU:** Press this key to go to the quick menu.
- 12. **ENTER/LIST:** Press to show channel list and favorite list on screen.
- 13. **Arrow Buttons:** Use to selec on-screen menu items and change menu values.
- 14. **BACK:** Display menu GUIDE in DTV mode. Return function in App.
- 15. EXIT: Exit the menu.


- 16. **COLOR BUTTONS:** Use to show the EPG or Program Edit menu.
- 17. **MUTE:** Press to cut off audio for the TV. Press again to resume audio.


Select MTS sound system. Press repeatedly to choose one of the modes (Mono, Stereo, Sap.). For DVD playback, press to adjust audio setting for the DVD.

Press to start the A-B repeat function.

- 19. VOL+/-: Press to adjust the volume.
- 20. **CH+/-:** Press to change channel.
- 21. **<--** During playback, press to select the previous track/chapter.
- 22. >> : During playback, press to select the next track/chapter.
- 23. ►II: Play/pause playback or begin to timeshift.
- 24. **INFO:** Display the program information.
- 25. ■: Stop playing or stop recording.
- 26. **VUDU:** If network connects, press to view VUDU directly.
- 27. **DVD TITLE:** Press to activate title on a loaded DVD.
- 28. ≜ : Press to eject a loaded disc.
- 29. **PANDORA:** If network connects, press to view Pandora directly.




### **ANTENNA CONNECTION**

Antenna input impedance of this unit is 75 ohm. A VHF/UHF 75 ohm coaxial cable can be connected to the antenna jack directly. If the antenna cable is a 300 ohm parallel flat feeder cable, you need to use the 300ohm/75ohm converter to connect the antenna cable to the antenna jack. ### **MENU OPERATION**

### **Input Setup**

Press INPUT on the remote control to enter the "INPUT SOURCE" menu. The following options will appear for you to select: "TV", "AV", "Component", "DVD", "HDMI1", "HDMI2", "Media".

Use the arrow keys to select an input source and press ENTER to confirm.



### **Channel Setup**

There are four ways to select a channel:

erased or not memorized.

- 1. Use the number keys and ENTER key on the remote control to select a channel directly. (To select channel 90, Press 9 0 ENTER.)

  When you use the number buttons, you can directly select channels that were either
- 2. Use CH+/- on the remote control or on the TV to select a channel. When you press the CH+/- keys, the TV changes channels in sequence. You will see all the channels that the TV has memorized. You will not see erased channels.
- 3. Press CH RTN to return to the previous channel. Press it again to return to the current channel.

To quickly switch between two channels that are far apart, tune to one channel, then use the number keys to select the second channel. Then use the CH RTN button to quickly alternate betwen them.

4. Select channels from the Channels List or Favorites List. Press ENTER to choose from the Channel List or Favorite List menu.

### **Volume Adjustment and Mute Setup**

Press VOL+/- on the remote control or the TV to display the Volume Menu. Adjust the volume of the TV between 0 and 100 by using VOL+/- keys.

### **MENU OPERATION - Continued**

To increase the volume, press the VOL+ key.

To decrease the volume, press the VOL- key.

### Mute


Press MUTE to turn off the audio playback. The MUTE icon will appear in the lower-left corner of the screen.

To resume sound, press the MUTE button again, or simply press the VOL+ key.



### **Current Channel Information**

Press INFO on the remote control to view information for the current channel. The indications of channel information are listed in the following table:



Press EXIT on the remote control to exit this OSD.

### PICTURE

- 1. Press MENU to display the main menu on the screen.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Picture option.
- 3. Press the right arrow key to enter the Picture submenu.
- 4. You can also press PICTURE on the remote control to select one of the picture settings.

### **Picture Mode**

Your TV has four picture settings (Sports, Normal, Mild, User) that are preset at the factory. Only User mode can be set to your preference by adjusting particular items, such as Contrast, Brightness, Color, Sharpness.

### **PICTURE - Continued**

### **User Settings for PICTURE**

Your TV has several settings that allow you to control picture quality.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select a particular item.
- 2. Use the left and right arrow keys to decrase or increase the value of a particular item.

The adjusted values are stored according to the selected particular item.

**Contrast:** Adjusts the lightness and darkness between objects and the background.

Brightness: Adjusts the brightness of the picture.

**Color:** Adjusts the colors, making them lighter or darker.

**Sharpness:** Adjusts the outline of objects to either sharpen them or make them more dull.

Tint: Adjusts the tint of the picture.

## Backlight

You can change the brightness of the entire screen according to your preference.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Backlight option.
- 2. Use the left and right arrow keys to increase or decrease the backlight value.


Backlight adjusts the brightness of the entire screen.

### **Color Temperature**

You can change the color of the entire screen according to your preference.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Color Temperature option.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the desired color temperature.

Cool makes whites bluish. Standard makes whites nature. Warm makes whites reddish.



### SOUND


- 1. Press MENU to display the main menu on the screen.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Sound option.
- 3. Use the right arrow key to enter the Sound submenu.
- 4. You can also press the SOUND key on the remote control to select a desired sound.

### **Sound Mode**

You can select the type of special sound effect you want to be used when watching a given broadcast.

Your TV has five sound settings ("Standard", "Music", "Movie", "Sports", "User") that are preset at the factory.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select Sound Mode.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select a desired sound.



### Balance

If the volumes of the left speaker and the right speaker are not the same, you can adjust the Balance to suit your preference.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Balance option.
- 2. Use the left and right arrow keys to decrease or incrase the value of the item.

### **AVL**

Each broadcasting station has its own signal conditions, and it is inconvenient to adjust the volume every time the channel is changed. AVL automatically adjusts the volume of the desired channel by lowering the sound output when the modulation signal is high or by raising the sound output when the modulation signal is low.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the AVL option.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to turn it on or off.

### **Surround Sound**

Surround sound is used to gain better sound effect.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Surround Sound option.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to turn it on or off.

### **Video Description**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Video Description option.
- 2. Use the left and right arrow keys to decrease or incrase the value of the item.

### **Digital Audio Output**

This is used to set the digital audio output.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Digital Audio Output option.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select Auto or PCM.

### Surround Sound

Surround sound is used to gain better sound effect.

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Surround Sound option.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to turn it on or off.

### **FUNCTION**

- 1. Press MENU to display the main menu on the screen.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Function option.
- 3. Use the right arrow key to enter the Function submenu.

### **Noise Reduction**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select Sound Mode.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select a desired mode to match your media.

### MPEG Noise Reduction

Use the left and right arrow keys to select between off/low/middle/ high modes. The picture will be better when it is in high mode.

### **Aspect Ratio**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Aspect Ratio option.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to change the size of the picture on the screen.

### **Link Setup**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Link Setup option.
- 2. Use the right arrow key or press ENTER to enter the link setup submenu.

**Enable Link:** use the left and righ arrow keys to turn link setup on or off.

**Auto Power On:** When this option is on and the TV is in standby mode, turning on the DVD can also turn the TV on at the same time.

**Auto Standby:** When this option is on and the TV is on, you can turn the TV off and also put the DVD into standby mode.

### **Netflix Deactive**

- Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Netflix Deactive option.
- 2. Use the right arrow key or press ENTER to confirm.
- 3. Press Yes to confrim again and Netflix will be activated

### **Netflix ESN**

Display the Netflix ESN information.

### **Netflix Version**

Display the Netflix version.

### **VUDU Deactivation**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Netflix Deactive option.
- 2. Use the right arrow key or press ENTER to confirm.

### **TTS**

You can set TTS information in the TTS menu.





### TIME

- 1. Press MENU to display the main menu on the screen.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Time option.
- 3. Use the right arrow key to enter the Time submenu.

### **Off Time**

Use the right arrow key or ENTER button to enter the submenu. Set the day & time you want to turn off the TV set.

### On Time

Use the right arrow key or ENTER button to enter the submenu. Set the day & time you want to turn on the TV set, when in standby mode.



### **Sleep Timer**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Sleep Timer option.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to set the desired time (Off, 10mins, 20mins, 30mins, 60mins, 90mins, 120mins, 180mins, 240mins).

The sleep timer you set will be cancelled when the TV turns off or if a power failure occurs. A reminder will display 60 seconds prior to a set sleep time, press any key to cancel the set timer.

### **Auto Sleep**

Use the up and down arrow keys to select the no signal power off features. If this function is turned on, the TV will turn off after 10 minutes without signal.

### **Auto Sync**

You can modify your TVs time in Manual Mode. In Auto Mode, the clock is decided by the DTV signal.

### Clock --:--

When Auto Sync is on, the clock is set from DTV streams. Set the clock manually when Auto Sync is turned off.

### **Time Zone**

You can choose this option to modify your TVs time zone.

### **OPTION**

- 1. Press MENU to display the main menu on the screen.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select Option.
- 3. Use the right arrow key to enter the Option submenu.

### **OSD Language**

- Use the up and down arrow keys to select the OSD Language option.
- 2. Use the right arrow key or press the ENTER button to select the desired language for OSD.

### **OSD Time**

Set the preferred amount of time for the OSD to be displayed on screen.

### **Closed Caption**

- Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Closed Caption option.

- 2. Use the right arrow key or press the ENTER button to confirm.
- Press Yes to confirm again. The TV will automatically turn off and reset to factory settings.

- 3. Press Yes to confirm again. The TV will update via USB. Please wait a few minutes and don't turn the TV off, it will turn off automatically once the update is completed.

This can update the TV via internet.

### **Network Update Information**

- 1. Press "f /,," key to select Network Update Information"
- 2. Press the ^ key to confirm.
- 3. Press Yes to confirm again. The TV will update via network connection. Please wait a few minutes and don't turn off the TV, it will turn off automatically once the update is completed.

### **User Mode**

Users can choose energy-saving mode here, if they wish to.



### LOCK

The Lock feature automatically locks out programming that is deemed inappropriate for children. The user must first enter a password before any of the lock restrictions can be set up or changed.

- 1. Press MENU to display the main menu on the screen.
- 2. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Lock option.
- 3. Use the right arrow key to enter the Lock submenu. An Enter Password menu will appear.
- 4. Enter your 4-digit password to enter the Lock submenu (default password is 1980).

### **Lock System**

Set the Lock function on or off.

### **Set Password**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Set Password option.
- 2. Enter your 4-digit password to enter the Set Password submenu.
- 3. Choose any 4 digits for your new password. As soon as the 4 digits are entered, the cursor will skip to Confirm Password.
- 4. Re-enter the same 4 digits to memorize your password.

When programs are locked, you can slo press the menu key, info key, and so on. Then use the left and right arrow keys to call back the input-password window.

### **USATV**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the USA TV option.
- 2. Press ENTER to open the USA TV menu.

### Canada English

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Canada English option.
- 2. Press ENTER to open the Canada English menu.

### Canada French

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Canada French option.
- 2. Press ENTER to open the Canada French menu.

### RRT Setting

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the RRT Setting option.
- 2. Press ENTER to open the RRT Setting menu.

### **RRT Reset**

### **Block Unrated TV**

### **DTV Manual Search**

Enter digital number and press ENTER to select a DTV channel.

### **ATV Manual Search**

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the ATV Manual Search option.
- 2. Press ENTER to open the submenu.

### **Current CH**

- Use the up and down arrow keys to select the second item.
- 2. Use the left and right arrow keys to select the current channel.

### Fine-Tune

- Use the up and down arrow keys to select the third item.
- 2. Use the left and right arrow keys to select a better frequency for the current channel.

### Signal Information (Used only in DTV)

- 1. Use the up and down arrow keys to select the Signal Information option.
- 2. Use the right arrow key or press the ENTER button to see the DTV channel information.




